### **Berlin, January 2, 2024**

In 2023, the German Spy Museum welcomed 441,537 visitors – that's 25,000 more than in the previous record year of 2019. After three years of pandemic-related declines, both Berliners and tourists are once again flocking to the museum.

The permanent exhibition, featuring unique spy gadgets, rare artifacts, and interactive experiences, proved especially popular with families. The laser course, lie detector, and bug-hunting activities make the museum a highlight for children and teenagers – birthday party packages are often fully booked months in advance.

International visitors to Berlin also value the museum, which is the only one of its kind in Central Europe. This year, they once again voted it among the Top 100 most popular tourist attractions in Germany.

Time-slot tickets are available online at a discounted rate – including in combination with the museum's sister institution, the award-winning »Deutschlandmuseum«, which opened in 2023 right next door and features an immersive exhibition on 2,000 years of German history.
